The Basics

clarity and specificity

Clarity is king. The clearer and more specific your prompt is, the better our Finetastic Ai Generator will understand what you want.

Instead of 'A dog', try 'Gunshow playing in the autumn leaves'.





Style and medium

Do you want an oil painting, a digital artwork or perhaps a comic strip? 'Gunshow sitting on a hill,

Van Gogh style

will give you something very different to a realistic picture of a dog' or try something different like Gunshow sitting on a hill, steampunk






Emotions and mood

Words that convey emotions and moods can change direction.

Gunshow lies on the beach,a peaceful sunset by the sea'

Gunshow lies on the beach,a dramatic sunset with stormy clouds.





Negative Prompts

Sometimes it is also useful to say what should not be in the picture, this is called negative prompts.

"gunshow in a shopping street without people, just an empty street with deserted shops"






Tipps and Tricks

<u>Use adjectives</u>

Adjectives are the spice for your prompts.

'happy, get flowers, sitting on a bank, comic' not only gives details, but also character.


chubby, get flowers, sitting on a bank, comic





Cultural nuances

Remember that

global database. A

not the same as for the
rest of the world. Be
specific with cultural
contexts.





Experimenting with perspectives

Our Finetastic Ai Generator loves to mix concepts. How about Gunshow as a samurai at the streets, in a cyberpunk Tokyo?





<u>Use references to</u> <u>what you know</u>

Referring to well-known works of art or cultural icons can help. 'Gunshow as the Mona Lisa. Painted by Leonardo da Vinci.'





Avoid mistakes

being too vague


A prompt that is too general, such as 'gunshow in the forest', could be anything from a squirrel to a dragon.





Overcomplication

Too many details can be confusing. Don't try to show everything in one picture. 'A dog playing in a meadow while a unicorn flies in the background and a rainbow shines, all in the style of Picasso' could lead to a surreal mishmash.





Contradictory instructions

'a dizzy, running gunshow' or descriptions that are logically mutually exclusive confuse the AI.





The magic of iteration

Prompting is not a one-shot deal.

It is a process:

- **Draft:** Formulate your idea.
- **Test:** See what Finetastic Ai makes of it.
- Refine: Adapt your description based on the result.
